As discussed during our call yesterday, please see our comments below in blue:

- 1. You are still affected by an unpleasant odour and polluted air from the shaft. You describe this as a metallic smell and that it prevents you from opening your windows. I noted this smell during my visit and from a communal area and was advised that it can be stronger than that observed at the time. The content of dust from the underground is mainly iron oxide which would explain the "metallic smell" being described. See our website for further information on the composition of the dust and what we're doing to reduce it. Reducing dust on London Underground Transport for London (tfl.gov.uk)
- You are concerned about the accumulation of black dust/ soot from the vent shaft on windowsills, balconies, internal and external plants, furniture, and carpeting and within the bike store. You say you are constantly cleaning to prevent a buildup of this in your homes, (one resident described residue around rugs, the black dust evident when

furniture is moved, another resident showed me a picture of black dust they wiped from the leaves of their indoor plants).

As above.

In addition, we use an independent company to do annual air quality monitoring across the Tube network. The results are published on our website <u>at link</u>. We take a targeted approach to reduce Tube dust levels in the most-affected areas, with specific cleaning in places where our monitoring has shown higher dust levels. In addition to tunnel cleaning, we have our cleaning team scheduled to clean the vent in October. Engagement is also underway with our engineering colleagues to understand what other measures can be undertaken to further reduce dust levels. Further details to follow regarding this.

3. You cannot use your balconies, avoid opening windows because of this and have raised concerns about what you and your families might be breathing in. one resident stated that a member of their family was asthmatic, and their symptoms were worse when they were indoors

The composition of Tube dust is significantly different from that of ambient air. While dust matter above the ground in the urban environment is made up of some components known to be harmful to health, Tube dust is predominantly made up of iron oxide. While the Committee on the Medical Effects of Air Pollution (COMEAP) do not claim iron oxide is harmless, they do state it is not currently known to be a carcinogen or have other significant health impacts. We are continuing to support research on the potential impacts of subway PM on people's health to address recommendations made to us by COMEAP in 2017.

- 4. You are concerned about the content of dust/ dirt/ soot deposits, levels of harmful PM10 and PM2.5 and what might harmful elements of this dust might be airborne. Answered above.
- 5. You are concerned there might be radiation in this material and wanted reassurance regarding this from TfL. As above
- 6. You are affected by noise from the Vent shaft which you describe as a persistent, audible stressor when you are home. You have noted the shaft has been 'reactivated' recently after a 10-month break and do not understand why this was necessary. In the winter months, the fans will be run at a lower speed, and increased over the warmer months to increase airflow on the network. The fans are maintained regularly to ensure they operate at the lowest possible levels and match the levels when installed.
- 7. You want to understand the plans for the green space close to the shaft and whether there is an option to 'adopt' this as extra green space. You are also concerned that if residential use is planned here, those occupants will face similar issues.
- 8. You want details of the previous planning permission granted for the blocks here and I said I would look into this.
- 9. You said you had previously requested details of the air quality monitoring undertaken by TfL when planning for your development but this had not been provided to date and you still would like this. I am not aware of this, but it seems Clarion are aware, and should be able to share that.
- 10. You said you had not reported the recent issues to Clarion but intended to.
- 11. You agreed to keep records of the time it takes for dust deposits to accumulate if possible one idea was to clean $\frac{1}{2}$ a sill, note the date and time and then track this for a week or two.

- 12. You said you would set up a WhatsApp group affected residents could use to share similar experiences and were happy to add my contact details to this.
- 13. You said you would keep in touch and arrange a re-visit in the event of significant changes in odour, noise or dust.
- 14. You said you want to meet in person with TfL and Clarion to discuss the above.

From the ground its difficult to tell as there could be another opening at the top somewhere else, pigeons seem to congregate around the outside of the openings at the top CAT ladder and on the window sill.

Guessing that is there way in & out.

I think it would be beneficial the add some extra spikes on the sills where there are no window openers, on both sides of the building.
