## Partial closure of Addiscombe Road for resurfacing works

From 08:00 on 21 October to 23:59 on 29 October we will be undertaking road resurfacing work on Addiscombe Road between Cherry Orchard Road and Bissenden Road.

The section of Addiscombe road marked with a red line in the image below will closed between the times stated above.



A diversion route will be implemented around, Cherry Orchard Rd, Lower Addiscombe Rd, Shirley Rd, Addiscombe Rd, Chepstow Rd and Fairfield Rd.

The road closure will also impact residents in a number of houses on Addiscombe Rd who will not have access or egress to their driveways during the closure dates and times.

We understand that this is likely to be a considerable inconvenience and apologise for this in advance. We ask these residents to park their vehicles on the neighbouring streets such as Colson Rd Blake Rd, Brickwood Rd and Bisenden Rd.

#### Trams closure

This work is scheduled to take place during a planned closure of the eastern section of the tram network as it is not possible to do it while the trams are running. There will be no tram service east of East Croydon tram stop from Saturday 21 October to 29 October. Normal service will resume on Monday 30 October.

The stops marked below in the blue box will be closed.



Replacement bus services will be in operation throughout the closure and will serve all the affected tram stops.

The closure will be widely communicated to local residents and stakeholders in the coming weeks.
