### December 2022

I simply can't take the noise level in the tube anymore. It's maddening. This is not one occurrence, it's every time, on most lines (bakerloo, Victoria, northern, etc.). I travel with noise cancelling headphones given how painful the noise is, but it seems to have gotten so bad that even with the noise cancelling, it's still maddening loud. What is happening? How could it be safe for passengers or staff? Please take this issue seriously and fix it just like you could fix it for the Elizabeth line.

## December 2022

Dear Tfl, I have been a tube commuter since 1997 and very much appreciate the efforts that you make to keep London moving. Before the pandemic I complained about rising track noise inside the carriages. The screeching is so bad, for example between Camden and Euston, that I have to close my ears to avoid actual physical pain. The reply I received at the time explained that changes had been made to the tracks in order to reduce vibration to properties above ground, that you were aware of the problem and were reviewing the situation. Three years on, nothing has changed. On the contrary, the noise is getting worse and it makes a tube journey an ordeal. What is being done about this? I know I am not the only one complaining, your own staff have told me they find it unbearable!

I have lived in my house for 30 years and I do appreciate that I live close to the underground but the noise is so very loud lately.

But all the trains seem to be much more loud this last month or so?

Is it that vegetation has been cut down or has works been carried out that isn't completed? So just to clarify, I live in xxxx.
