Summary of how the route Only one very short section of the route does not meet the quality criteria, a 50m section where it uses The Drive to pass between Exeter performs against the Quality Gardens and Cowley Road. With flows of around 620 vehicles during the AM peak and an 85th%ile speed of 32mph, this short stretch does not Criteria meet the Quality Criteria and should be reviewed.
