Hi Lucinda

Happy to explain further **below** but if you have any further queries on what Buses have / have not done recently and are committed to at the moment, I would need Paul Lawley CCed to input...

The original S 106 contained £4,248,000 (excluding indexation) of Bus contributions.

Those were – excluding indexation.

£1,620,000 Route 390 Improvements (£540,000 x 3)

£498,000 Route 63 Improvements (£166,000 x 3)

£1,215,000 Route 394 Improvements (£405,000 x 3)

£915,000 Route 214 Improvements (£305,000 x 3)

We have so far received £2,116,800.00 from LB Camden back in February 2017 (see below). This was for the 390. It therefore seems this was the £1.62m but index linked to that point.

The 63 improvements are now cancelled and £400k from that funding is now going to be used for the High Line.

This leaves at least £2,131,200 left in the overall 'pot'. More actually, due to index linking.

The DoV affects those sums in these ways:

- If the £400k is not spent by the council on the High Line within 3 years of the date of the deed then it can be spent either by TfL on buses or the council on other infrastructure and public realm works;
- · If the Route Contributions already paid have not been spent or applied within 3 years of the date of the deed then they can be spent either by TfL on buses or the council on other infrastructure and public realm works;
- · If the £400k or the Route Contributions already paid have not been applied or committed within 5 years of the date of the deed then they will be repaid to the developer;
- If the Route Contributions not yet paid under the s 106 are paid and then not applied or committed within 10 years of payment then they will be repaid to the developer.
