

GLA 2001 No. 061 The A202 GLA Road (Queens Road) (Prescribed Route) (No.2) Traffic Order 2001

Made Coming into force 13th February 2001. 26th February 2001.

Transport for London, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into force on the 26th day of February 2001 and may be cited as the A202 GLA Road (Queens Road) (Prescribed Route) (No.2) Traffic Order 2001.

Prohibitions

- 2. No person causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the A202 Queens Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to-
 - (a) turn right into Asylum Road, Lausanne Road, Lugard Road or Pomeroy Street; or
 - (b) turn left into Pomeroy Street.
- 3. No person causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the GLA side road Pomeroy Street shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn right into Queens Road.
- 4. No person causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the GLA side road Lausanne Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn left into Oueens Road.


Exemptions

- 5. Nothing in articles 2, 3 or 4 of this order shall apply to-
 - (a) any person causing any vehicle to proceed for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Revocation of existing order

6. The Lewisham and Southwark (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1966(b) is hereby revoked.
