THE A202 GLA ROAD (QUEEN'S ROAD) (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (No.2) TRAFFIC ORDER 2001 VARIATION ORDER 2009

Made 3rd September 2009

Coming into force 14th September 2009

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The A202 GLA Road (Queen's Road) (Prescribed Route) (No.2) Traffic Order 2001 Variation Order 2009, and shall come into force on 14th September 2009.

2. Variations

The A202 GLA Road (Queens Road) (Prescribed Route) (No.2) Traffic Order 2001^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 3. After the sub-title, Exemptions, article 5(c) is added as follows:
 - '5. (c) the controls specified in Article 2(a) do not apply to cyclists wishing to turn right into Asylum Road.
