### Note of meeting held at Transport for London's Palestra office on Monday 20 January 2020

1. Mr Khosrawshahi said that he wanted to pay a short courtesy visit to TfL on his way to the World Economic Forum in Davos. It was agreed that there would be no discussion of any detailed regulatory issues given that Uber is appealing against TfL's decision not to grant a taxi and private hire licence. These matters would be considered by the Magistrates Court in due course.
2. Mr Khosrawshahi reiterated Uber's intention to deal with all of TfL's concerns as part of the court process and was committed to continuing with its programme that had changed the culture of the organisation. The safety of passengers remained Uber's top priority and there would be an open dialogue to ensure that all matters were addressed. The steps taken would be set out during the court proceedings.
3. There was a discussion about environmental issues and the urgent need to tackle climate change. Uber would, among other things, be pressing ahead with its plans to introduce more electric vehicles and working with cities to ensure availability of more charging points etc.
