Good afternoon, hope you are well?

This morning I attended a meeting with representatives ([REDACTED]) from Lambeth Council along with local Cllr Fred Cowell. This meeting was a joint meeting between the MPS, TfL & Lambeth Council to discuss the recent LaserCam deployments we have conducted on A2199 Croxted Road, SE21. This enforcement activity has been generated by a London Borough Speed Referral and having now undertaken the initial 8 hrs of enforcement action the location is above the 15% non-compliance threshold, thus triggering the meeting this morning. I have attached the data from the LaserCam activity which has already been shared with [REDACTED].

During this meeting we outlined that whilst we are committed to a further 8hrs of enforcement activity beyond this our ability to redeploy in the future might be limited due to resources and competing demands for the LaserCam. It was discussed that apart from signs & lines there has been no engineering solution implemented to make the road look and feel like a 20mph road and thus this is potentially contributing to the evident speeding issues.

[REDACTED] are considering what options are available to Lambeth Council going forward and would welcome your input and advice on this location from a TMO's perspective.

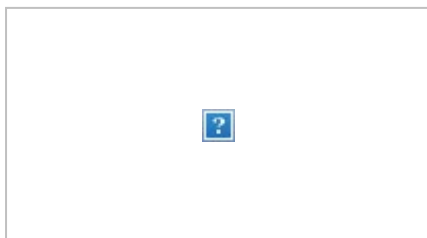
