My colleague [REDACTED], the Road Safety Portfolio Sponsor in our team, has sent me a recent response from our Compliance, Policing, Operations and Security (CPOS) team.

In regards to the installation of new safety cameras, we are not currently in a position to support individually funded safety cameras. In our Vision Zero Action Plan, we committed to expanding London's safety camera network as part of efforts to reduce speed or speed-related collisions and noncompliance in the capital. This is still our intention but we are not in a position to do so now. We are undertaking the essential preparatory work for this and ensuring we have all the necessary elements in place before rolling out new camera sites. This includes implementation of offence processing technology, recruitment of enforcement staff, and exploring new camera technology to ensure that we are investing in the best and most cost-effective systems for the future.

Once we are in a position to expand the network, we will need to redo the detailed analysis to prioritise locations for safety cameras, using a methodology that was developed in consultation with the boroughs and London Councils prior to the pandemic. We need to do this to take account of any changes in travel projections and road user behaviour, as well as the significant changes made to road layouts during the pandemic.

Are there any physical measures that could be implemented on Croxted Road to help reduce speeds?

Dear Rezina

At the July meeting of the full council I submitted a question about Croxted Road speed cameras.

There was a very reassuring and welcome response from you to our question which included a broader commitment to look at this in the context of reduction of speeding hotspots.

Your response also included a commitment to work with the police on securing a location for a camera on the road. We have reached out to the police's speed watch team's but this has taken a while and we have not really got anywhere with them beyond a community speedwatch.

In the meantime, there have been two horrendous accidents on Croxted Road directly arising from speeding. One, on the 19<sup>th</sup> of September, resulted in a child being hospitalised with surgery needed on their leg.

I am apologise, for being apocalyptic about this but given the pattern of high-speed collisions on the road there is a real possibility of a speed-based fatality on this road.

I am writing to ask that we can have your intervention on this matter and if we can move forward trying to get a speed camera on the section of the road that Lambeth is responsible for. As a reminder the Southwark section already has a speed camera.

Very happy to meet on this to discuss this further or to have an update if you can give it on progress on this
