The implementation of this scheme could affect flows and reassignment for the GTC future base model, and we would need to flag this to team to agree if and how this should be reflected in the models.
I understand a decision on the Hills and Vales scheme is expected by the end of this year – so this might fit with GTC timescales for the Future Base, although as the scheme is to be implemented as an ETRO we would need to jointly agree what to show.
