THE A4 AND A30 GLA ROADS (LONDON BOROUGHS OF HILLINGDON AND HOUNSLOW) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2021



Coming into force 18th November 2021

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

- This Order may be cited as The A4 and A30 GLA Roads (London Boroughs of Hillingdon and Hounslow) (Speed Limits) Order 2021 and shall come into force on the 18th November 2021.
- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. The GLA Roads (London Borough of Hounslow) (Speed Limits) Order 2016^b and The GLA Roads (London Borough of Hillingdon) (Speed Limits) Order 2016^c and The A4 and A30 GLA Roads and A3006 Side Roads (Great South West Road, Bath Road and Great West Road) (London Borough of Hounslow) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2015^d are hereby revoked, in so far as any of its provisions relate to any lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

Lengths of GLA Road subject to a speed limit of 30 miles per hour:

Table	
(1) Item	(2) Length of Road
1.	A4 BATH ROAD, both sides, from a point 4 metre west of the western kerb line of Travellers Way to the Roundabout at the junction of Great South-West Road (A30) And Burns Way.
2.	A30 GREAT SOUTH WEST ROAD, both sides, from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Lancaster Place to the Roundabout at the junction of Bath Road (A4) and Burns Way.
3.	A4 GREAT WEST ROAD/BATH ROAD, both sides, from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Springwell Road to the Roundabout at the junction of Great South-West Road (A30) and Burns Way.
4.	The Roundabout at the junction of Bath Road (A4), Great South-West Road (A30) And Burns Way, for its whole length.

SCHEDULE 2

Lengths of GLA Road subject to a speed limit of 40 miles per hour:

Item	Length of Road
1.	A30 STAINES ROAD/GREAT SOUTH WEST ROAD, both sides, from the administrative boundary of Surrey County Council to a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Lancaster Place (as much as lies within the London Boroughs of Hounslow and Hillingdon).
2.	A4 BATH ROAD, both sides, from a point 4 metre west of the western kerb line of Travellers Way to the administrative boundaries of the London Boroughs of Hounslow and Hillingdon.
3.	A4 GREAT WEST ROAD, both sides, from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Springwell Road to its junction with A4 Cedars Road.
