We have been working with our trade unions to see how we can make London Underground a fairer and more sustainable place. We want to make London Underground a better place to work so we urge ASLEF and the RMT to call off this damaging strike and continue working with us.”

Notes to editors

- There are currently no changes or proposals for change on pensions
- TfL’s proposals for changes to how it rosters station staff do not involve any redundancies
- TfL is in consultation with its trade unions to seek their views on how it can make London Underground more efficient and financially sustainable, while continuing to deliver the highest standards of safety, reliability and customer service. Any proposals to deliver the change needed to make London Underground fairer, more efficient and financially sustainable would be subject to established and thorough processes for working with Trade Unions
