

PUBLIC NOTICE:

THE TRAFFIC DIRECTOR FOR LONDON

A316 Kew Road / Lower Mortlake Road, London Borough of Richmond

The Traffic Director for London, following a direction given to him by the Secretary of State under section 58(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 to implement a Trunk Road Local Plan, is proposing to convert some lengths of footway on the A316 Kew Road (Richmond Circus) and Lower Mortlake Road to cycle track using powers under section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980.

The new cycle tracks will be in total approximately 1.06 km long located at the following points.

- on the south side footway of A316 Kew Road (Richmond Circus) and Lower Mortlake Road, from the west side of 28 Kew Road to the west side of Sheendale Road;
- on the south side footway of A316 Lower Mortlake Road, from the east side of Victoria Villas to the west side of Manor Road;
- on the north side footway of A316 Lower Mortlake Road, from the west side of Pagoda Avenue to the west side of Sandycombe Road.

Cyclists and pedestrians will share the full width of the new cycle tracks, with each having equal rights over it. Signs and road markings will be used to mark the start and end of the cycle track, and will make clear where the footway has been converted to a cycle track.

The proposal is in accordance with the provisions contained in the Traffic Director for London's Trunk Road Local Plan as varied, a copy of which can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:
