A10 Kingsland Road junction of Stamford Road & Tottenham Road improvement scheme

We communicated with you to back in July 2015 to inform you of our proposals to close Stamford Road and Tottenham Road off from vehicular traffic at its junction with A10 Kingsland Road. It has taken us some time to refine this work and get to implementation.

What are we proposed?

We proposed to improve the section of Kingsland Road south of Dalston Junction, making it easier for all road users. Please see plan overleaf for more information.

The scheme involves closing two side roads, Tottenham Road and Stamford Road, that lead on to Kingsland Road to motor vehicles only.

The proposals form part of our Healthy Streets programme to improve walking and cycling in London, enhance safety for vulnerable road users on the TLRN (Transport for London Road Network).

Overall this means the following changes are proposed:

- Removal of the median strip on Kingsland Road, which restricts lane widths and causes conflicts between road users.
- Closure of Stamford Road and Tottenham Road to vehicular traffic.
- Provision of a new inset loading bay.
- Creation of a new public space with new street furniture.
- Introduce new facilities for cyclists, improving access to the Cycle Superhighway Route 1 between Tottenham and the City of London.
