## THE A201 GLA ROAD (SWINTON STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF CAMDEN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

Made 7<sup>th</sup> December 2023

Coming into force 16<sup>th</sup> December 2023

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as 'The A201 GLA Road (Swinton Street, London Borough of Camden) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2023' and shall come into force on 16<sup>th</sup> of December 2023.
- 2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Camden should be prohibited from making certain movements and stopping on a section of the A201 Swinton Street because works are being executed.
- **3.** From 7:00 AM on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2023 until 7:00 PM on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
  - (1) enter or proceed on Swinton Street between its junctions with Swinton Place and Gray's Inn Road, local access to be maintained between Swinton Place and the extended common boundary of Nos. 45 and 47 Swinton Street;
  - (2) stop on Swinton Street between its junction with Gray's Inn Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 45 and 47 Swinton Street;

This Order will also permit two-way operation on:

(3) Swinton Street between its junction with Swinton Place and the extended common boundary of Nos. 45 and 47 Swinton Street.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

**4.** (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
  - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
  - (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle:
  - (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- **5.** At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
