THE A3, A23, A202 GLA ROADS (KENNINGTON PARK ROAD, KENNINGTON ROAD AND CAMBERWELL NEW ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) BANNED TURN TRAFFIC ORDER 2015

Made 22nd June 2015

Coming into force 28th June 2015

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The A3, A23 A202 GLA Roads (Kennington Park Road, Kennington Road and Camberwell New Road, London Borough of Lambeth) Banned Turn Traffic Order 2015, and shall come into force on 28th June 2015.

2. Banned Turns

- (1) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding in a north-easterly direction on the A3 Kennington Park Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn left onto the A202 Harleyford Street, except cycles;
- (2) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding in a south-easterly direction on the A23 Kennington Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn left onto the A3 Kennington Park Road;
- (3) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding in a north-westerly direction on the A202 Camberwell New Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn left onto the A23 Brixton Road;

3. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing in article 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
