

Hi

We had a meeting with etc from the ATM recently; subsequent to which a revised signing design has now been drawn up. My colleague (etc) (copied in) will send you some more relevant info we discussed with the ATM.

A 40mph limit will now replace the 50mph west of Crittalls Corner, so existing cameras 4475 and 4477 will need to be recalibrated to 40mph.

One of the engineering requirements was no new signposts on the central reservation unless width allowed, whilst maintaining adherence to TSRGD. So, if you could have a look at the draft design attached. If there are any issues, please don't hesitate to let me know. If we could have any comments ASAP, then the final design can be priced by our term contractors; when the signs works take place, the average speed cameras will be erected by Yunex within the same night time lane closures.
