THE A13 GLA ROAD (COMMERCIAL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

Coming into force

19th January 2024

Transport for London having consulted the London Borough of Tower Hamlets and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A13 GLA Road (Commercial Road, London Borough of Tower Hamlets) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2024 and shall come into force on the 19th January 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets should be prohibited from making certain movements on a section of A13 Commercial Road and stopping on White Church Lane and New Road because works are being executed on Commercial Road.
3. Between the dates of 19th January 2024 and 5th February 2024, every Friday at 11:00 PM until the following Monday at 5:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit:
 - (1) any vehicle to enter, exit or proceed on Commercial Road between its junctions with A11 Whitechapel High Street and White Church Lane. Local access will be maintained on Commercial Road between its junction with White Church Lane and the extended eastern building line of No.32 Commercial Road;
 - (2) any vehicle to stop on White Church Lane between its junctions with Commercial Road and A11 Whitechapel Road/Whitechapel High Street;
 - (3) any vehicle to stop on New Road between its junctions with Whitechapel Road and Commercial Road;

- (4) pedal cycles to enter, exit or proceed on the south-westbound cycle track on Whitechapel High Street between its junctions with Commercial Road and Leman Street.

The Order will also prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on the:

- (5) southern footway of Whitechapel High Street between its junctions with Commercial Road and Leman Street;
- (6) western footway on Commercial Road between its junctions with New Drum Street and Whitechapel High Street.

- 4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:

- (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
- (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
- (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs.
