## **THE A3220 GLA ROAD (HOLLAND ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024**

*Coming into force*

*4th February 2024*

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A3220 GLA Road (Holland Road, Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 4th February 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea should be prohibited from making certain movements on the A3220 Holland Road because works are being executed.
3. Between the dates of 4th February 2024 and 7th April 2024, every Sunday at 7:00 AM until Sunday at 7:00 PM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
  - (1) enter, exit, proceed or stop on Holland Road between its junctions with Napier Place and Kensington High Street;
  - (2) stop on Warwick Road, between the extended common boundary of a and b St Mary Abbot's Garages, Warwick Road and a point 16 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 3 and 4 St Mary Abbot's Garages, Warwick Road.
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

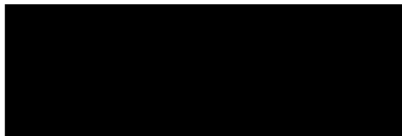

- (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
- (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
  - (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
  - (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs.
