### THE A24 GLA ROAD (MERANTUN WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND BANNED LEFT TURN) ORDER 2024

*26th January 2024*

*Coming into force*

*5th February 2024*

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A24 GLA Road (Merantun Way, London Borough of Merton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Banned Left Turn) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Merton should be prohibited from proceeding on certain sections of the A24 Merantun Way because works are being executed.
3. Between 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024 and 24<sup>th</sup> August 2024 every night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to;
  - (1) enter, exit or proceed on Merantun Way between its junctions with Watermill Way and Morden Road, local access will be maintained between Watermill Way and High Path link road connecting Merantun Way with High Path;
  - (2) turn left into Merantun Way from Christchurch Road.
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
    - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
    - (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;

(iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
