THE A406 GLA ROAD (BOWES ROAD - NORTH CIRCULAR ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF ENFIELD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order: -

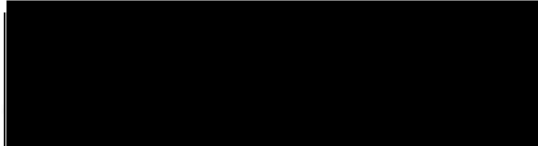
1. This Order may be cited as The A406 GLA Road (Bowes Road - North Circular Road, London Borough of Enfield) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 24th January 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Enfield should be prohibited from making certain movements and stopping on a section of the A406 Bowes Road because works are being executed.
3. Between 24th January 2024 and 24th April 2024 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
 - (1) enter or exit Warwick Road at its junction with the A406 Bowes Road (North Circular Road);
 - (2) stop on the westbound carriageway of the A406 Bowes Road (North Circular Road) between its junctions with Livingstone Road and Natal Road;
 - (3) stop on the westbound carriageway of the A406 Bowes Road (North Circular Road) between its junctions with Highworth Road and Stanley Road;
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
 - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;

- (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
- (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
