THE A200 GLA ROAD (JAMAICA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

22nd December 2023

Coming into force

26th December 2023

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A200 GLA Road (Jamaica Road, London Borough Of Southwark) (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic And Stopping) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 26th December 2023.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that Traffic in the Borough of Southwark should be prohibited from making certain movements on A3200 Jamaica Road because works are being, or are proposed to be, executed.
3. From 7:00 AM on 26th December 2023 until 7:00 PM on 30th December 2023 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
 - (1) enter, exit, proceed or stop on the westbound carriageway of the A200 Jamaica Road between its junctions with Southwark Park Road and Drummond Road. Local access only will be maintained between Lower Road and Southwark Park Road;
 - (2) enter, exit, proceed or stop on Drummond Road between its junctions with Perryn Road and the A200 Jamacia Road
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - (2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
 - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;

- (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
- (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
