PUBLIC NOTICE

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2)

THE A10 GLA ROADS (BISHOPSGATE, NORTON FOLGATE, GRACECHURCH STREET, EASTCHEAP AND THREADNEEDLE STREET, CITY OF LONDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

Transport for London hereby gives notice under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that due to carriageway patching works, traffic in the City of London will be prohibited from making certain movements in a certain section of A10 Bishopsgate, Norton Folgate, Gracechurch Street, Eastcheap and Threadneedle Street.

Between 27th December 2023 and 29th December 2023 every day from 06:00 AM until 6:00 PM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, no person shall cause or permit:

- (1) Any vehicle to enter, exit, stop or proceed on Bishopsgate between its junctions with Leadenhall Street/Cornhill and Wormwood Street/Camomile Street;
- (2) Any vehicle to enter, exit, stop or proceed on Bishopsgate/Norton Folgate between its junctions with Commercial Street/Great Eastern Street and Wormwood Street/Camomile Street;
- (3) Any vehicle to enter, exit stop or proceed on Threadneedle Street between its junctions with Bishopsgate and Finch Lane. Local access will be maintained between Finch Lane and Adam's Court;
- (4) Heavy good vehicle to enter, exit, stop or proceed on Gracechurch Street between its junctions with Eastcheap, Cannon Street and King William Street and the common boundary of No.37 to 41 and No.40 Gracechurch Street;
- (5) Heavy good vehicle to enter Eastcheap at its junctions with Gracechurch Street, Cannon Street and King William Street.

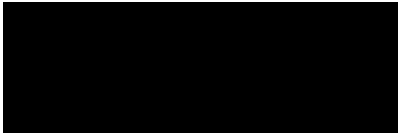
The restrictions will only apply during such times and to such an extent as is indicated by traffic signs.

The restrictions will not apply to any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works, or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

At such times as the prohibitions are force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs for traffic **travelling south westbound** via Camomile Street, Outwich Street, Houndsditch, St Botolph Street, Aldgate High Street, Aldgate and Leadenhall Street to normal route of travel. For traffic from Cornhill **travelling north eastbound** via Leadenhall Street, Aldgate, Aldgate High Street, St Botolph Street, Duke's Place and Bevis Marks to

normal route of travel. For traffic **in Gracechurch Street** via Fenchurch Street, Leadenhall Street, Aldgate, Aldgate High Street, St Botolph Street, Duke's Place and Bevis Marks to normal route of travel. For traffic travelling **from King William Street/Cannon Street** via Eastcheap, Great Tower Street, Byward Street, Tower Hill, Minories, Goodman's Yard, Mansell Street, St Botolph Street, Duke's Place and Bevis Marks to normal route of travel **HGV traffic accessing Gracechurch Street and Eastcheap** via King William Street, Fish Street Hill, Upper Thames Street, Southwark Bridge, Southwark Street, Blackfriars Bridge, Queen Victoria Street, Puddle Dock, Upper Thames Street eastbound and Lower Thames Street to normal route of travel.
