### THE A4 GLA ROAD (WEST CROMWELL ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

*26<sup>th</sup> January 2024*

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A4 GLA Road (West Cromwell Road, Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea should be prohibited from making certain movements on West Cromwell Road because works are being executed.
3. From 7:00 PM on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024 to 7:00 AM on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2024, 7:00 PM on 2<sup>nd</sup> February to 7:00 AM on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024, 7:00 PM on 8<sup>th</sup> March to 7:00 AM on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and from 7:00 PM on 22<sup>nd</sup> March to 7:00 AM on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, exit or proceed eastbound on West Cromwell Road between its junctions with North End Road and Warwick Road.
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.  
  
(2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
  - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
  - (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;

(iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
