THE A1203 GLA ROAD (THE HIGHWAY) (LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

18th January 2024

Coming into force

26th January 2024

Transport for London having consulted the London Borough of Tower Hamlets and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A1203 GLA Road (The Highway) (London Borough of Tower Hamlets) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2024, and shall come into force on the 26th January 2024.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets should be prohibited from making certain movements and stopping on A1203 The Highway because works are being executed on that road.
3. Between 8:00 AM on the 26th January 2024 and 5:00 PM on the 15th April 2024 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
 - (1) stop at the northern kerb-line of The Highway between the junctions of Ensign Street and Breezers Hill;
 - (2) enter, exit or proceed on Virginia Street between its junction with The Highway and a point 23 metres southwards;
 - (3) stop at the eastern kerb-line of Virginia Street between the junctions with The Highway and Pennington Street.
4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

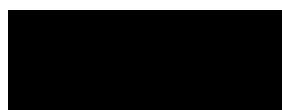
(2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:

- (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
- (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
- (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
